Pre Festival Poster/Program Distribution (April 20 – the festival)

Are you so excited for the festival this year that you can't wait until June to start volunteering? Why not try poster/program guide distribution! You will be assigned an area of town (you could even request your own neighbourhood) and you can get out and enjoy our beautiful city while helping us distribute promotional materials for the festival. The fun doesn't stop there though, we encourage you to volunteer in this area, PLUS another one so you still get to hang out with all of us during the festival.

Artist Hospitality

Do you enjoy hosting? Catering to people's needs? Does reading social cues and respecting people's privacy come easily to you? Consider artist hospitality, where you will keep the backstage area clean, calm, inviting, and filled with all of the artists' favourite food and drinks. Assistance in lifting, clean-up, and load-in/ load-out up and down the theatre stairs may be required.

Front of House

Do you have experience in customer service and cash and credit card handling that you just love to show off? We would love to see that in front of house! Here you will be handling door ticket sales, and checking people in to will call and guest-list.

Merchandise Sales

Is there an inner sales person in you? Are you familiar with cash/credit card handling and customer service? Many of the venues sell festival t-shirts, VJS memberships, and artist merchandise, and you could be there to help someone find their next favourite purchase!

Green Team

Do you enjoy being outside, listening to music, and helping the environment? Are you okay with walking around on concrete? Volunteers look after bike parking, assist in cleaning up the site, hand out program guides to festival goers, and manage the recycling and compost programs at our outdoor Centennial Square site.

Beverage Concessions

Have you ever worked in a bar? Wanted to work in a bar? What about an outdoor area where people can buy drinks and it's kind of like a bar? Volunteers are needed to assist in the set-up and operation of the "Beverage Garden" at Centennial Square. **Must be 19 years of age or older / Must possess valid Serving it Right or SES license / Shifts only available during performances at Centennial Square / Must be physically able to assist in lifting kegs (able to lift ~50lbs)**

Staging & Site Set-Up/Tear Down

Ever wondered how the equipment gets on and off the stage? Or how the fencing gets moved around the Centennial Square site? It could be you doing it! We require people with varying levels of experience **who are able to lift**.

- Staging: assisting in loading/unloading equipment, set-up and strike of equipment; be on hand to assist as needed during performer change-overs at Centennial Square.
- Set Up/Tear Down: assisting with setting up and striking the outdoor festival site at Centennial Square as well as installation and removal of on-site banners & signage (*Set up: Thurs & Fri, June 18 & 19 / Tear down: Sun, June 28*)

Office

How do you feel about sitting in a comfy office chair? Have you worked in an office before? Are you detail oriented even when you've been doing the same task for hours? Are you comfortable with professionally answering the phone? Volunteers needed pre-festival, as well as during to help out around the VJS office.

Transportation

Do you enjoy driving? Do you have a license that allows you to drive a 15-passenger van or maybe even a box truck? Volunteers will be driving performers to and from the arrival/departure terminals, to hotels as well as venues for load-in and sound checks. You will be required to provide a copy of a valid driver's license. **Must be over the age of 25 and have a basic knowledge of city streets. Our primary need is those with a Class 2 or 4 Driver's Licenses, secondary need is those with a Class 5.**

Event Crew

Are you responsible, reliable, and good at staying friendly and calm in large crowds? If people were acting out in the crowd do you think you could confidently speak up? Do you mind standing for long periods of time? During the Festival we will require volunteers to act as crowd/access control for front of house, stage, and backstage areas. **Volunteers must be 19 years of age or older.**

Videographer/Photographer

Do you have a camera and feel pretty confident with your skills? During the festival these volunteers will take video and/or photos at the TD JazzFest venues. Please provide experience. Volunteers MUST have own equipment.

Survey Team

Do you like walking around and chatting with people while they wait for the show to start? During the festival, volunteers will take hard copy surveys and go survey audiences at various TD JazzFest venues. The information we collect gets used for government grants, and stays in house only.
